- 4) Play by the rules:
 - Abide by the referee's decision. MRBA have zero tolerance for any disrespect shown to umpires.
 - Verbal Abuse of officials, supporters or other players is not permitted, again zero tolerance.
- 5) Swearing at any time is not permitted, on court, off court, whilst representing MRBA. Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Team Effort achieves more.
- 6) Both at Home & Away, your behaviour whilst at Basketball and within the Community can affect team selection and travelling with MRBA Hawks teams. It is a privilege to be a Hawk. Co-operate and be respectful to the Coach, Assistant Coach, Manager, Referees, Parents, Spectators, BWA Officials and team members.

- 8) Do not engage in practices that affect sporting performance (alcohol/tobacco/vaping/drugs/poor diet)
